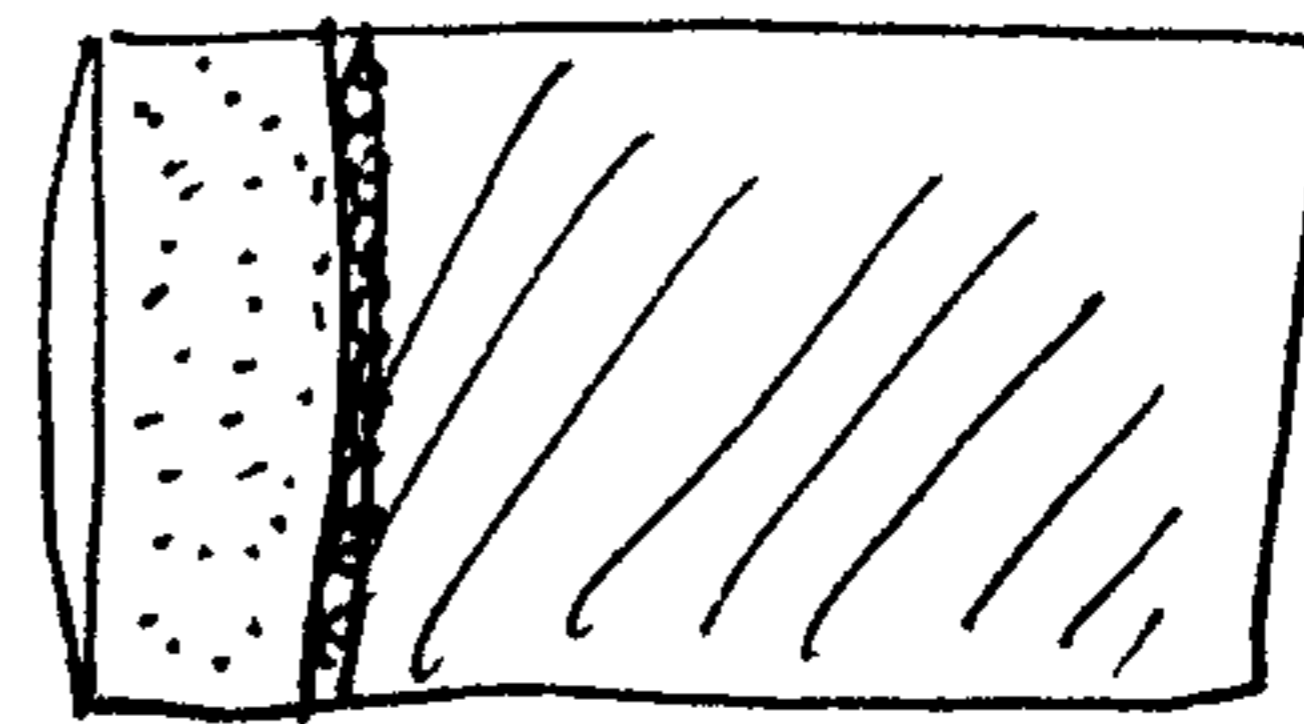


Pillowcase Directions

Yardage needed: $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of main color
 $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of border
1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " of trim



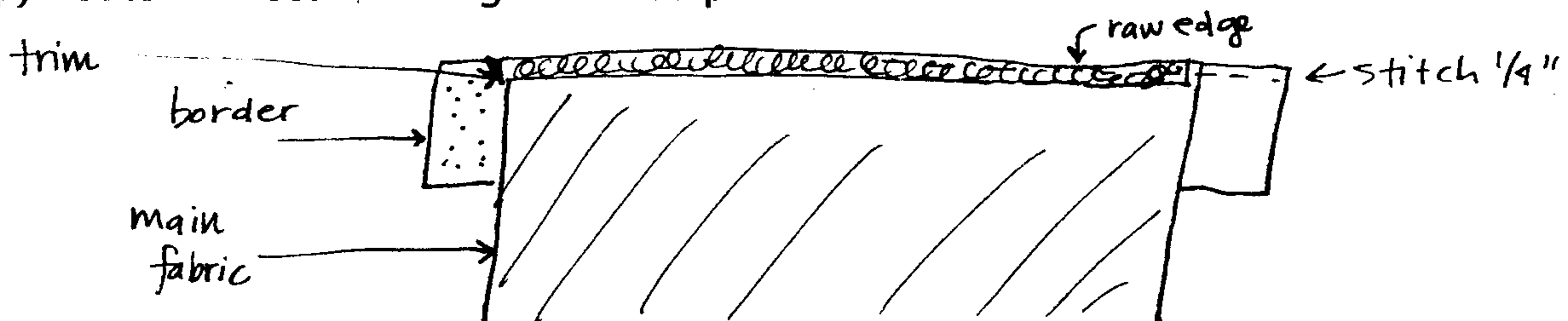
You don't need to prewash the fabric, but you can (allow for shrinkage if you do).

Take the $\frac{3}{4}$ yard piece with selvages even and still folded, trim edges so they are straight (should be about 27 X 42).

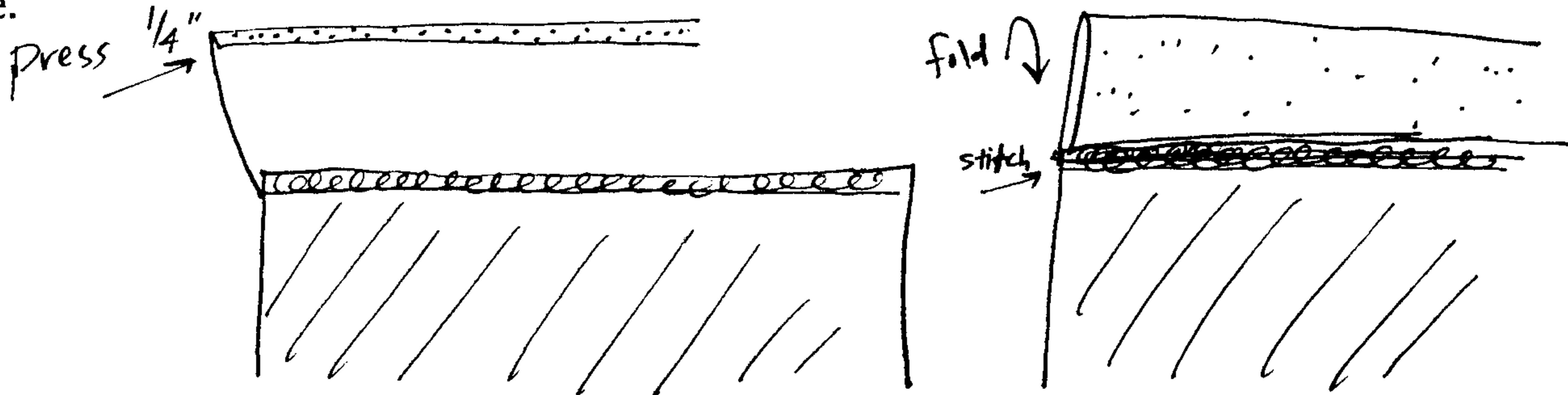
Trim the $\frac{1}{4}$ yard piece so the ends are even. Should be about 9" wide.

Cut a trim piece of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " across the width of third fabric. Iron in half lengthwise.

Place the border right side up. On top of the long side, place the large piece right side up. On top of that, place the folded trim strip with raw edges even (at top). Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam through all three pieces.



Open out border. Press seam towards the border. Press under $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the edge of the border, and then fold border in half and press. Make sure that the folded edge of the border is over the seam line (pin if necessary). Stitch close to folded edge.



Fold pillowcase in half, with right sides together. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " around the side and bottom.

Zig-Zag stitch around the edges to finish.
